WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER?	ALL students (kids, teens & adults) of ANY grade (including novices) are eligible and encouraged to enter. Team kata division is open to advanced students, 6 <sup>th</sup> kyu (yellow belt) and above.

**Ages 5-7** will do their first round of kata in a **group** to a **count**. 3 judges will collectively choose competitors for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round. Judges will choose 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the final round.

Ages 8-12 (white, orange & blue belts) will do their first round of kata in a group to a count. 3 judges will collectively choose competitors for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round. Judges will choose 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the final round.

**Ages 8-12 (yellow belts)** will do their first round of kata **individually** to a **count**. 3 judges will collectively choose competitors for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round. Judges will choose 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the final round.

Ages 8-12 Advanced (green & brown belts) will do their elect kata individually mugore (no count).

Judges will use IKO scoring method, and highest scores will go on to the next round. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be chosen from scores.

**Teens & Adults** will do their elect kata **individually** *mugore* (no count). Judges will use IKO scoring method, and highest scores will go on to the next round. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be chosen from scores.

**Team KATA:** Minimum of three team members, yellow belts and above (all ages). Teams will perform their elect kata **individually** *mugore* (no count). Judges will use IKO scoring method, and highest scores will go on to the next round. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be chosen from scores.
