Ages 5-7 will do their first round of kata in a **group** to a **count**. 3 judges will collectively choose competitors for the 2nd round. Judges will choose 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the final round.

Ages 8-12 (white, orange & blue belts) will do their first round of kata in a **group** to a **count**. 3 judges will collectively choose competitors for the 2nd round. Judges will choose 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the final round.

Ages 8-12 (yellow belts) will do their first round of kata **individually** to a **count**. 3 judges will collectively choose competitors for the 2nd round. Judges will choose 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in the final round.

Ages 8-12 Advanced (green & brown belts) will do their elect kata **individually mugore** (no count).

Judges will use IKO scoring method, and highest scores will go on to the next round. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be chosen from scores.

Teens & Adults will do their elect kata **individually mugore** (no count). Judges will use IKO scoring method, and highest scores will go on to the next round. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be chosen from scores.

Team KATA: Minimum of three team members, yellow belts and above (all ages). Teams will perform their elect kata **individually mugore** (no count). Judges will use IKO scoring method, and highest scores will go on to the next round. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be chosen from scores.
